

Everything you need to know about ERIN'S LAW



Erin's Law requires all public schools to implement a prevention-oriented child sexual abuse program which teaches:

- Students in grades PreK-12th age appropriate techniques to recognize child sexual abuse
- School personnel all about child sexual abuse
- Parents and guardians the warning signs of child sexual abuse, referral or resource information to support sexually abused children and their families
